


# How to install the login form of the cloud system SignToLogin into your Web site.

1. Log into the SignToLogin web site. You will see your profile page.

4. Click the button “Edit company” and you will see the form. Then put your Callback URL into the appropriate field and click “Submit”. The Callback URL is used to send the data to after successful authorization.

5. Switch to the tab “Account”.

6. Copy the code that you will see in the field “Widget code” at the tab “Account” and put it into your Web site where authorization is needed.

7. If authorization is successful the signtologin.com gives the following data back:

- uid=317
- hash=02ec7863d8c562ad0623594f5a4b95b6
- first\_name=User’s Name
- last\_name=User’s Last Name

Where:

- uid – the SignToLogin’s user ID
- hash – MD5 hash function which is calculated on the base of the Company’s ID and the Company’s secret key.
- first\_name – User’s name
- last\_name – User’s last name

Data is returned to the Callback URL which was mentioned at the fourth step.
